

As we continue with the Fall Sports Season, I am writing this memo as a reminder to our member schools to continue to promote and expect good sportsmanlike behavior from the student-athletes, coaching staff, and spectators. This is the part of the season where winning plays a bigger role in determining post-season play opportunities. Nonetheless, good sportsmanship should remain a priority throughout the season.

Congratulations to the member schools whose athletic teams competed last week with no ejections for unsportsmanlike behaviors. Unfortunately, some of the member schools had ejections of players and/or coaches for unsportsmanlike behavior. Last week 14 member schools had ejections of players and/or coaches, and there were two post-game incidents of unsportsmanlike behavior after the officials had left

the playing area. And once again, one of the member schools has had two weeks of ejections. If change is to occur, the member schools' administration will have to take on a bigger role in being proactive as it relates to expectations of good sportsmanship. In the words of former SCHSL Associate Commissioner Skip Lax, "When it comes to unsportsmanlike behavior, if we permit it, we promote it." As we embrace another week of athletics competition, I challenge the member schools, those without ejections last week, to continue the good work. And for those with ejections last week, to complete this week of athletic competition without ejections.

For the first time, the SC High School League is excited to offer a middle school volleyball regional invitational on Saturday, October 22. In preparation for this event, we are sharing the application process and requesting a response from your program. Application process: To be considered for the tournament, at the end of your season, your school will need to submit an application, due no later than October 18th. The application form will be on the League's website. Schools with multiple teams will be able to submit an application for one team only. Teams who are selected will have to pay a \$125 entry fee. A championship trophy will be presented to the winner of each regional tournament.

Teams will be selected by a committee on October 19th using the following: •Overall record

•Tournament record (if applicable)

·Conference record (if applicable)

·Conference tournament finish (if applicable)

•A maximum of 8 teams will be selected for each regional site.
