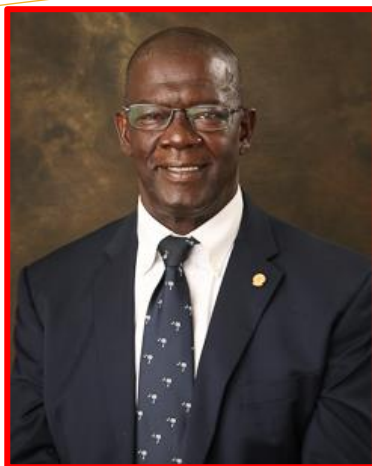

Last week, we concluded all state finals in girls' golf. Over the past two weeks, four state golf champions and four state golf runners-up were crowned. Congratulations to all who participated. I trust the experience was rewarding and created pleasant memories.

The role of athletics in the member schools continues to be relevant to the educational experience, and the member schools recognize its value to the school and the community. While these events create great opportunities for community support, it is also sometimes supercharged with emotions that occasionally compromise the display of good sportsmanship. All contests should be played with an intense desire to win, otherwise let's not keep score.

However, the desire to win must be tempered with the teaching of good sportsmanship. As stated in previous correspondences, good sportsmanship must continue to be a **PRIORITY**, and unsportsmanlike behavior continues to be a **CHOICE**.

This past week showed a slight improvement in the number of schools that had ejections for unsportsmanlike behavior during the contests. 13 schools had ejections and three of the 13 schools had coaches ejected for unsportsmanlike behavior. While corrective measures for athletes' ejections usually result in the temporary suspension of eligibility to participate, coaches' ejections result in the suspension of coaches and fines to the schools. With today's finances, schools can find a better use for their funds than paying avoidable fines.

To the schools with no ejections this past week, congratulations. Job well done. Keep up the good work. To the school with ejections this past week, continue to address the matter and continue to make good sportsmanship a priority. To all schools still participating, good luck in the competition this week.

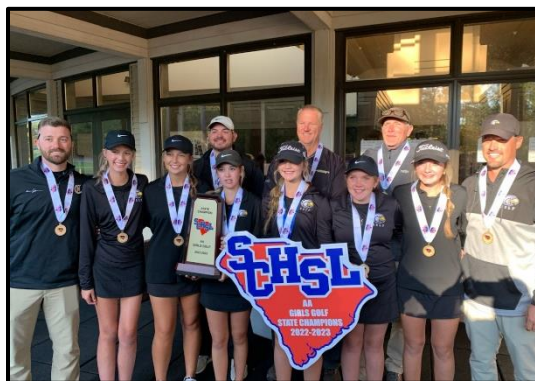

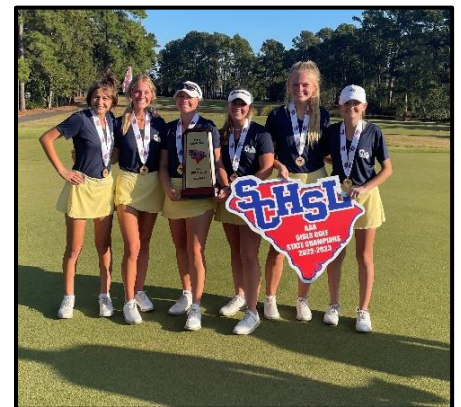
Oct. 17-18 and Oct. 24-25 the SCHSL held its 2022 Girls Golf Championship. After the Tournament four teams were crowned Champions.

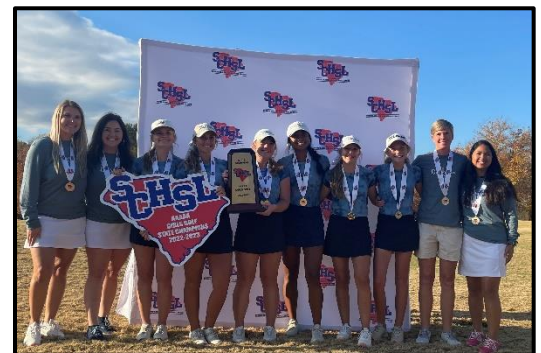
