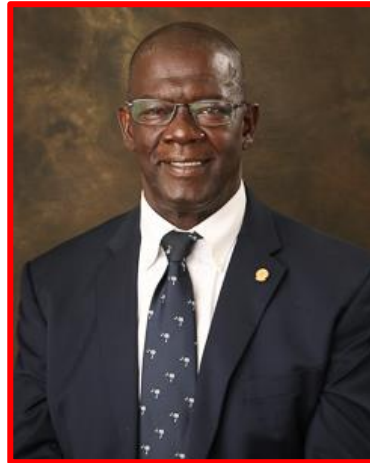

I trust that everyone had an enjoyable break and is re-energized to take on the ongoing and new challenges to be faced during the remainder of this school year. While your work is never done, please be reminded that it is critically needed and greatly appreciated.

Last week's tragic incident during the Cincinnati Bengals – Buffalo Bills football game remind us all of the importance of health and safety procedures for our student-athletes. It goes without saying that properly working "AEDs" and "Emergency Action Plans" are critical to the health and safety of all involved in education-based athletics. Some of our member schools have had personal catastrophic experiences in their athletics programs/events and know all too well the value of intentional actions when crises occur. With that in mind, please take the opportunity to review and practice your emergency action plan(s) for practices and athletics events.

Additionally, I ask that sportsmanship continue to be a focus for teachable moments as athletics practices and competitions occur. During the past few weeks, multiple ejections have occurred for unsportsmanlike behaviors/actions. Since the last report, 18 schools have had ejections of athletes and/or coaches. Fortunately, most of the member schools are competing without ejections for unsportsmanlike actions/behaviors. These schools are to be Commended and Congratulated. Unfortunately, some of the member schools are experiencing athletes' and/or coaches' ejections for unsportsmanlike actions/behaviors. Sadly, some schools experiencing ejections during the Winter sports season are also the ones that experienced ejections during the Fall sports season. Recognizing this is unacceptable, schools are asked to take deliberate actions to address these actions/behaviors.

My wish for all member schools is continued success in your athletics programs. Have a great remainder of the week and have a great week of athletics competitions.

UPDATED CREDENTIAL PROCEDURES

Beginning with the 2023 Wrestling State Finals scheduled for February 11, 2023, credential requests must be submitted online on or before the respective deadline (see below). There is only **one** media credential allotted per school. Credential requests must be done by a school official (Principal, Vice Principal, Athletics Director, or their designee). **Deadline must be met. No email requests will be accepted.**

Credential form will be available under the Communications tab on the SCHSL website (www.schsl.org) one week prior to the deadline.
