

Sarah Hayes joins the staff at the South Carolina High School League (SCHSL) as an Associate Commissioner.

She joins the League after serving as the Athletics Director at Battery Creek High School for three and a half years (2019-2023). During the 2021-22 school year, she was named the Class AAA Athletic Director of the Year and Region 8-Class AAA Athletics Director of the Year by the South Carolina Athletic Administrators Association (SCAAA).

During her time as the Athletics Director at Battery Creek, Hayes was instrumental in the renovations of the athletics facilities, including upgrading to a state-of-the-art weight room and installing a video scoreboard the football stadium.

Before being named the Athletics Director, Hayes was the Head Girls' Varsity Basketball coach for five years (2014-2019). She finished her coaching career with a 72-51 record, and in 2016 she led her team to the Regional Championship and a trip to the Lower State

Semi-Finals.

Hayes received her Bachelor of Arts degree in History and Psychology from Brown University in 2006. A member of the Brown Women's Basketball Team, she was named Ivy League Rookie of the Year, Ivy League Player of the Year, and an Academic All-American. Hayes was the second player in Ivy League history and first at Brown to amass 1,000 points, 600 rebounds, 250 steals, and 250 assists in a collegiate career.

Upon completing her undergraduate studies, Hayes played professional basketball in Germany with the USC Freiburg Eisvogel Women's Basketball Club from 2006-2011. While in Freiburg, she led basketball camps sponsored by the German American Institute of Freiburg and was a guest lecturer at the Freiburg Institute for Sports and Sports Science.

After playing, Hayes served as an Assistant Women's Basketball Coach at Carnegie Mellon University (2011-2013). In addition to her coaching duties, she was the event manager for men's and women's soccer and an undergraduate fitness instructor.

In 2018 she received her Master of Science in Athletic Administration with a focus on Interscholastic Athletics from Ohio University.

Hayes is a member of Battery Creek High School Athletic Hall of Fame and is a former member of the SCAAA Executive Board as the AAA Lower State Representative from (2021-2023). As a member of the Board, she served on the Awards Committee, Scholarship Committee, and Mentoring Committee. She is a Certified Athletic Administrator (CAA).

She is the mother to a handsome young boy named John.



Maeoceisha Suber-Jenkins joins the staff at the SCHSL as the Administrative Assistant.

Suber-Jenkins brings over five years of administrative and front desk experience to the SCHSL. Prior to coming to the League, she spent one year with the Richland County School District 1 (2021-22) as an Office Support Assistant/ Dispatcher. From 2018-2020 she served as the Customer Service Advocate for the City of Columbia.

A native of Eastover, S.C., Jenkins-Suber received her Esthetics Certification from Southeastern Esthetics Institute in June 2021.

As the mother of a teenage daughter (Za'Nhyriah (DJ)), Jenkins-Suber saw a need during the Pandemic for a virtual safe space for girls and created the non-profit, Guiding Steps for girls ages 8-17 in the Eastover, SC community.
