True Fans Unite to Promote Positive Behavior in High School Sports

Attention, high school sports fans!

Not those of you who are disrespectful, volatile, and even violent at athletic events. No, we're talking to parents and fans who behave appropriately and understand the true purpose of high school sports.

First off, we want to thank you: For not yelling at the officials every time you don't like a call. For not ruining high school sports for your child by making it all about you. For not contributing to the bad fan behavior epidemic that is putting high school sports at risk.

Like you, we're tired of seeing games canceled because of brawls in the stands. We're tired of entitled fans who think they can say and do anything they want. We're tired of high school athletic events being clouded by negativity, immaturity, and aggressive behavior.

Let's not let a few bad apples spoil the bunch. They may be a loud minority, but let's make sure our actions speak louder.

Consider this your rallying cry—to continue setting the tone for your school community, to continue being role models and positive behavior trailblazers, and to continue being part of the solution and not part of the problem.

Please share with those you deem appropriate.

As an update to ejections for unsportsmanlike behavior over the past two weeks, I share the following data:

MARCH 6- MARCH 19, 2023

- 51 member schools had ejections of coaches and/or student-athletes: (50 high schools; 1 middle school)
- Five (5) coaches were ejected, all high school coaches: (2 baseball, 2 soccer, 1 softball)
- 59 student-athletes were ejected: 58 high schoolers; 1 middle schooler: 35 soccer, 17 baseball, 4 lacrosse, 1 softball and 1 tennis.

As you can see, there is much work to be done. Let's also adopt this "Call to Action" letter for our coaches and student-athletes. I wish you continued success during this Spring sports season and have a great remainder of the week.
