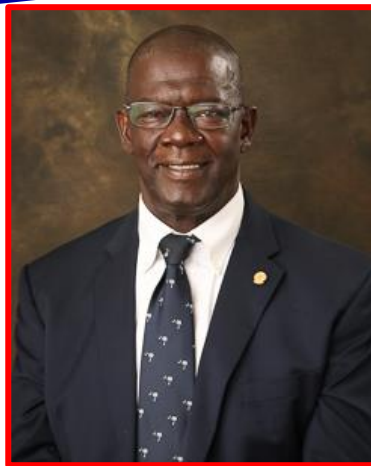

SCHSL CONTINUES TO CELEBRATE TITLE IX

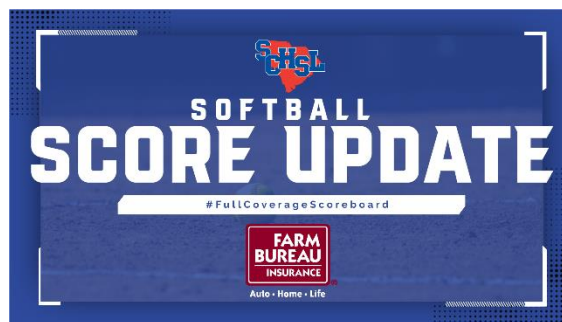
