Blake Betette Richland Northeast High School

The SCHSL is pleased to announce the 2024 November Student-Athletes of the Month. Raegan Griggs of McBee High School is the SCHSL Girl's Student-Athlete of the Month and Blake Betette of Richland Northeast High School is the SCHSL Boy's Student-Athlete of the Month.

Griggs is a junior track and field athlete. She carries a 4.5 grade point average and currently ranks in the Top 3 in her class. She is enrolled in AP and dual enrollment college courses.

Griggs recently set school records in the 1600 and 800 meter runs and was two seconds off from tying the 400- meter school record just 14 minutes after winning the 1600-meter in the same meet in Darlington. She has been a Class A State qualifier in tennis singles and track & field for three consecutive years.


Griggs is a member of the Future Farmers of America, and a Boys & Girls State poetry participant, where she recently qualifying for National competition. She is the Captain of the Tennis & Track & Field teams.

Betette, is a senior three-sport athlete at Richland Northeast High School. He is a member of the football team, baseball team and track and field team. Betette carries a 4.908 grade point average. He currently ranks in the top 10% of his graduating class and is a member of the National Honor Society and has the highest GPA on the football team.

Betette is a well-rounded student-athlete as he is a member the Student-Athlete Advisory Council (SAAC) and was selected as an all-region football player (2024). He received two varsity letters in baseball (8th and 9th Grade) and two varsity letters in track & field (9th and 10th grade).

His leadership and extracurricular activities include Participating at the High-Five Mornings at Forest Lake Elementary; Participating at the Leaders as Readers for Conder Elementary; Participating in National Honor Society Campus Clean-up, and he is a member of the Junior House (Student-Government) and is a Horizon Ambassador (school magnet program).
