Commissioner's Chat & Beyond



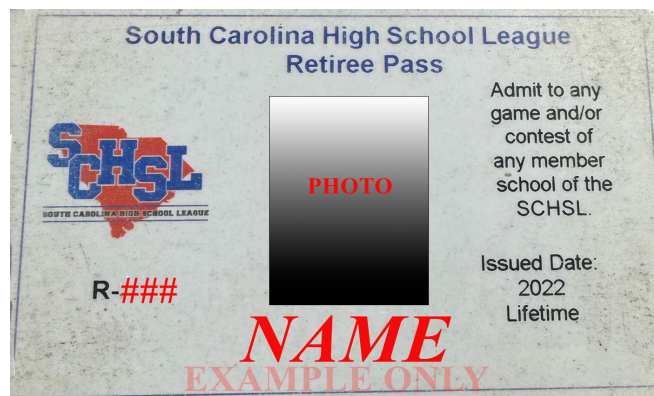
