Tips to Promote Positive Behavior at Contests

As regular season contests begin, here are a few tips to promote positive behavior at your events. These tips help create a positive environment that all will enjoy, and officials will enjoy coming to, time-and-time again.

1. Select a student to read the PA Announcement at contests. Involving students in the process will encourage everyone to pay attention to the important message and give them a leadership role in your athletic department.
2. Take care of inappropriate behavior swiftly to show others what is not tolerated at your contests. What you permit, you promote!
3. Develop and post positive behavior sportsmanship messages at your athletic facilities that can be seen by all who attend, coach, and play. Additionally, model the message that you send!
