## 2025 SCHSL GIRLS WRESTLING STATE CHAMPIONS

On Saturday, February 7, 2026, the South Carolina High School League (SCHSL) hosted the 2026 Girls Wrestling Duals State Finals. The League crowned its Inaugural 4A State Champion along with the 5A Champion.

Chester High School and Chesnee High School were the 4A participants while Rock Hill High School and Greenwood High School were the 5A participants.

At the end of the Duals, Chester was crowned the Inaugural Class 4A Champions and Rock Hill High School repeated as the Class AAAAA State Champion. Rock Hill was the first-ever SCHSL Girls Wrestling Champion (2025).

## NO SMOKE, NO PROBLEM?

### NICOTINE HURTS YOUR BODY NO MATTER HOW YOU USE IT

Nicotine products like e-cigarettes/vapes and oral pouches (like Zyn) are *highly addictive*. Nicotine actually primes adolescent brains for addiction, increasing the likelihood of other substance use.

It's basic science, but it can have lasting consequences. In the short-term, nicotine increases feelings of pleasure and concentration, but in the long-term nicotine addiction can cause physical and emotional stress.

Nicotine *in any form* is not safe, especially for youth. **Here are just a few ways in which nicotine harms the body:**



#### BRAIN

Nicotine can change brain chemistry and is linked with an increased risk of psychiatric disorders such as major depressive disorder and bipolar disorder.



#### SKIN

Nicotine constricts the blood vessels, which prevents nutrients from getting to the skin. This may cause premature aging and wrinkles.



#### HEART

In addition to increasing heart rate and blood pressure, nicotine also narrows the arteries, which increases the risk of a heart attack. Recent data show that people who vape experience cardiovascular damage similar to people who smoke.



#### LUNGS

Smoking cigarettes and/or vaping limits lung capacity over time, which can also cause illnesses like chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD).

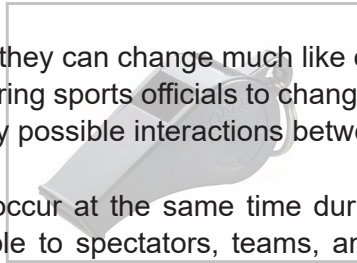

### Spring Sports Officials Plan

Spring sports contests are beginning. Do you have a plan for the spring sports officials that come to your school? Below are some tips on how to take care of the spring sports officials who come to your facilities.

- 1) If able, have a clean facility in which they can change much like other sports.
- 2) If unable to have a facility for your spring sports officials to change, provide a separate parking area for officials. This will help to prevent any possible interactions between spectators and officials before and after contests.
- 3) Many contests at your facility can occur at the same time during the spring season, be vigilant and walk around your facility. Be visible to spectators, teams, and officials to help provide a safe environment for all.
